Piece of Furniture: Meaning	Devil's Counterfeit	How it was restored by God!
Altar of Sacrifice: Jesus died on the cross for our sins	People can earn or buy their salvation...	Martin Luther (Lutherans) realized that the just shall live by faith and not by penance or indulgences. Jesus is the beginning of our journey when we accept His free gift on the cross!
Lavar: baptism	Babies can be baptized through sprinkling...	John Smythe and Roger Williams (Baptists) believed in Jesus' example of baptism by immersion. It means that the old self is symbolically left in the water and the new you comes up as a new creation!
